

Grammar Uniform Clarifications

Boys and girls regular uniform shoes: solid black, grey, white, or any conservative combination of these three colors, lace up or Velcro (no slip-ons). Examples:



Girls dress uniform shoes: black or navy dress shoes (1" heel or less). Examples:



Boys dress uniform shoes: sturdy black or dark brown (not tennis shoe style). Examples:
