

Drama

To letter in Drama, an actor/crew member must meet the following criteria:

Character: Actor/crew member must be of good standing in the community.

- Be of good character. An actor/crew member must show respect at all times to directors, cast, and crew as well as to the greater school community. A lettering actor/crew member is coachable, humble, selfless, and an encouragement to others.
- Contributes positively to the production's success (at rehearsal, at performances).
- Is a good steward of time (homework, assisting in other production areas) when not actively working on a scene.

Academics

An actor/crew member must remain academically eligible for the duration of the season and maintain a 2.5 GPA or higher. Academic ineligibility prior to or after the season does not prevent lettering.

Rehearsals and Time

- Be a cast or crew member for at least two productions. An eligible crew member is one who is involved from the beginning of the production period, assisting in set and prop design and stage managing.
- Attend all rehearsals and performances unless excused by the director, parent, or doctor.
