Colors: Solid black, brown, or dark gray shoe. No colored or white sole - sole color must be similar in color shading to the upper portion of the shoe.

Material: Leather, faux leather, suede, cloth.

Style: Dress shoe. No boots 2" higher than ankle. Pants must cover the top of the shoe.
Colors: Solid black, brown, or dark gray shoe. No colored or white sole - sole color must be similar in color shading to the upper portion of the shoe.

Material: Leather and faux leather are preferred, but cloth and suede are also acceptable if suitably dressy and following style and color guidelines.

Given that pants come from different stores, you may find different shades of khaki. The chart below shows what shades are accepted, with the exception of the camel-colored "British Khaki," which is not acceptable.

## Girls regular uniform shoes:
