Following is a list of supplies recommended for each grade level for the 2017-2018 school year. To ensure your child's best success with these supplies, please do the following:

1. Purchase brands and items as described. Please do not substitute stipulated sizes or quanity of items unless unavoidable.
2. Please put your child's name on as many items as possible.
3. Frequently check and replenish supplies as needed throughout the year. Christmas break is a perfect time to replenish. -Thank you!

## Pre-Kindergarten:

Please bring the following items to school labeled with your child's name on the day of the ice cream social:

- 1 box of 12 pre-sharpened colored pencils, labeled with initials
- 1 watercolor paint set of 8 colors, labeled with name
- 6 glue sticks
- 1 pair metal children's scissors - Fiskars is a nice brand, labeled with name
- 1 box 24 Crayola brand crayons - Box labeled with name
- 1 school box for holding supplies (needs to clasp shut and be cigar-box size approximately 8 "x 5 ")
- 1 bottle of Elmer's glue
- 2 packages baby wipes
- 1 large box of tissues
- 1 Paint Shirt
- $14 \times 6$ photo of your child for our bulletin board

Please bring the following items to school with your child on the first day of school:

- 1 durable plastic folder with pockets, any color-no zippers or closures
- Book bag - with handles and an open top. (Example - cloth, reusable grocery sacks.) Please no backpacks.
- Water bottle labeled


## Kindergarten:

Please purchase brands and items as described.

- 1 set of washable markers-classic colors-broad tip (not fine tip) 8-12 count
- 8 glue sticks (no store-brand please; they don't work well or last well)
- 1 pair scissors for kids (Fiskars is a good brand), labeled with first name
- 1 zipper pencil pouch, labeled with first name
- 14 oz . container of Elmer's glue-white
- 1 school box for holding supplies (needs to have a good solid clasp to shut and be approximately 8 "x 5 ")
- 2 Expo dry erase markers - fine point (blue, black, or purple)
- 1 backpack - normal sized (big enough to put folders, books, art projects, pencil box, etc.)
- 1 water bottle with name
- 1 long -sleeved paint shirt - please write name on collar (it should have sleeves long enough to cover long sleeve dress uniform shirt/blouses, but not so long that the cuffs need to be rolled up several times, please.)
- 1 eraser or old sock for white board erasing
- 2 large boxes of wipes
- 2 large boxes of tissues


## First Grade:

Please purchase brands and items as described.

- 1 dozen \#2 Ticonderoga pencils to be shared with class (unlabeled)
- 2 red pencils to be shared with the class (unlabeled)
- 1 box standard size crayons - 12 count
- 3 glue sticks
- 14 oz . container Elmer's white glue, labeled with student name
- 1 pair blunt tip scissors for kids, labeled with student name
- 1 composition book (any color except blue, may be wide or college ruled, please label with name on the front)
- 2 large boxes of tissues
- 4 large boxes of unscented baby wipes
- 1 standard size backpack
- 1 water bottle labeled with name
- 1 old sock for white board erasing
- 1 long-sleeved paint shirt (labeled with student name)

## Second Grade:

Please purchase brands and items as described.

- 2 glue sticks
- 1 dozen Dixon Ticonderoga \#2, soft pencils (see below)
- 1-24 pack of colored pencils (Prang)
- 1 pair Fiskars scissors (Please make sure that you have safety scissors that cut neatly and do not merely crease the paper.)
- 2 Staedtler erasers (white eraser with paper covering)
- 1 zipper pouch for colored pencils - needs to be big enough to hold them all
- 1 zipper pouch for all other pencils, markers, scissors, etc. It is helpful if the two pouches are two different colors/patterns.
- 1 each colored plastic folders with pockets and brads in the middle: black, purple, pink, and yellow
- 1 black composition notebook (for writing)
- 4 black dry erase markers-Expo
- 2 large boxes tissues
- 2 packages of baby wipes
- 1 personal pencil sharpener (for colored pencils)
- 1 backpack
- 1 personal Bible: NKJV only (big enough to read easily, small enough to fit in the desk. Thin is better!)
- 1 long-sleeved, button up paint shirt

Dixon Ticonderoga pencils write more clearly than other pencils. They are not plastic, and therefore sharpen better. They also have better erasers, so the student's work is not smudged.

- 1 dozen Dixon Ticonderoga \#2, soft pencils
- 1 box of 24 good quality colored pencils (basic colors including black, no neon or metallic, NOTCrayola or Roseart )

- 2 zipper pouches (one for colored pencils, one for scissors, eraser, highlighter, etc) (non plastic - they tear too easily)

- 1 black and white marbled composition book
.3 large boxes of tissues (2 boxes in September and 1 box in January)
. 3 packages/boxes of baby wipes (2 packages in September and 1 box in January)
