2. Please put your child's name on as many items as possible.
3. Frequently check and replenish supplies as needed throughout the year. Christmas break is a perfect time to replenish.

Pre-Kindergarten:

Please bring the following items to school all *labeled* with your child's name on the night of our Back to School Dessert:

- 1 box 8 Crayola "Write Start" colored pencils
- 1 watercolor paint set of 8 colors
- 4 glue sticks
- 1 pair Fiskars metal children's scissors
- 1 box 24 Crayola brand crayons
- 1 school box for holding supplies (needs to clasp shut and be cigar-box size approximately 8"x 5")

Grades 7 and 8:

Please purchase brands and items as described

- 1 backpack or book bag
- 1 package of blue or black pens (rollerball or ballpoint recommended – not felt)
- 5 red pens (rollerball or ballpoint recommended – not felt)
- 1 dozen #2 pencils (or mechanical pencils with #2 lead with sufficient refills)
- Locker shelving optional
- 1 student planner
- Binders or other system sufficient for 6 classes (For example: 5 – 1½” inch 3-ring binders **or** 2 to 3 – 2in. binders to hold 2 or 3 subjects per binder)
- 3 large boxes of Kleenex (give to first period teacher)
- 1 package unscented baby wipes (give to first period teacher)
- 2 Expo or Quartet dry erase marker (any dark color)
- 1 or white board eraser

10th-12th grade (also recommended for 9th grade):

- 1 Laptop required. Multiple written assignments, research projects, and Power Point / Google Doc presentations are assigned to students, particularly in the Humanities and Rhetoric. A basic inexpensive laptop or Chrome Book capable of word processing and presentation applications is sufficient.

10th grade English:

- 1 dedicated 2” three-ring binder for English with internal pockets and set of 5-6 divider tabs is strongly recommended. Alternatively, students may opt to use a 1.5” binder for literature and a 1” binder for composition/research.

12th grade English:

- 1 black and white marbled college-ruled composition book

MUSIC:

- 1 one-inch, black three-ringed binder with internal pockets label for music (**it should not have plastic gloss** on the outside) Heavy duty!

MATH:

- 200 sheets of graph paper with ¼” squares
- 1 Texas Instruments TI-30X IIS calculator, available at Amazon for \$15 (9th grade only)
- 1 TI-83 or TI-84 graphing calculator (10th – 12th grade only) Assignment instructions are given for Texas Instruments TI-83 and TI-84, not Casio or other model. These can be found second hand, as new ones are expensive.
- 1 locking compass and protractor (9th grade only)
- 1 ruler with standard and metric measurements

RHETORIC

- Laptop for 11th and 12th grade Rhetoric

BIBLE:

- 1 personal Bible: NKJV only, to be left at school

LATIN (grade 9 and 10 only):

- 1 dedicated 1.5” three-ring binder for Latin with internal pockets (or space in a shared binder). Please use a binder for Latin rather than an accordion folder, envelope, or other system.
- 1 package of 5-6-tab dividers or pocket dividers for binder (the tabs you can write on are very convenient). **Please label tabs before the first day of school. Label one tab each in the following order: 1) Vocab** (for vocabulary lists); **2) HW**

- 1 package of 5-6-tab dividers or pocket dividers for binder (the tabs you can write on are very convenient). Please label tabs before the first day of school. Label one tab each in the following order: **1) Vocab** (for vocabulary lists); **2) HW** (homework/assignments); **3) T/Q** (graded tests and quizzes); **4) Gramm** (for grammar handouts); **5) Ref** (reference); and **6) paper** (this tab is optional for regular lined notebook paper).
- (Optional: 3x5 index cards, white or pale pastel colors; tab dividers; card storage box; some students prefer to make and use vocabulary cards; some students may be required to use cards)
